The children get to interact with Mother Goose. They especially love to help her remember the lines of rhymes familiar to them. They get to touch the black sheep's wool when we do Baa Baa Black Sheep, jump over a candle (unlit) for Jack Be Nimble, touch an actual cow horn with Little Boy Blue, and get to be just a wee bit startled by a cute stuffed mouse while reciting Hickory Dickory Dock.

MOTHER GOOSE will come to your site to read and entertain the children.

Schedules fill up quickly, so please plan your special time with Mother Goose as soon as possible. Many schools plan a year in advance.

We truly do have a fun time and I hope you will invite MOTHER GOOSE to read rhymes with the children.
